AB ORIENTE features music from Eastern and Central Europe and the Middle East. Enjoy traditional and contemporary music from Poland, Hungary, Romania, the Czech Republic, Slovenia, Bulgaria, Greece, the Balkans, Russia, Georgia and the Middle East.

Also on this concert is the world premiere of *Three New Motets in memoriam Thomas Tallis*, a new commissioned choral work by the 2005 Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Steven Stucky. *Three New Motets* is commissioned as part of the national series of new works from Meet The Composer *Commissioning Music/USA*, which is made possible by generous support from the National Endowment for the Arts, The Helen F. Whitaker Fund, and the Target Foundation. The commission is a national consortium involving Seattle Pro Musica, the Phoenix Bach Choir, the Kansas City Chorale and the Grinnell College Singers.
